The Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) has reviewed the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Part A and Part B Renewal Permit Application submitted by Esterline-Armtec Countermeasures on March 3, 2017, revised May 1, 2017, July 11, 2017, and October 23, 2017 (hereafter referred to as the Part B Application) to ensure compliance with Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission (APC&EC) Regulation No. 23. ADEQ proposes to issue a Renewal Permit (hereinafter Permit 26H-RN2) to Esterline-Armtec Countermeasures for the RCRA Open Burn Unit (OBU), which consists of four (4) elevated burn pans.

Any request for a hearing must include the requestor's name and address and shall state the nature of the issues to be raised in a hearing. ADEQ will issue a public notice of a hearing at least thirty (30) calendar days prior to the scheduled hearing.

Any individuals, including the applicant, who wish to comment, request a public hearing or add their names to the mailing list concerning ADEQ decisions relating to the permit or application, must do so by hand delivering or mailing written comments, along with their name and mailing address to: Charles M. Comments supporting or opposing the tentative decision will provide legal standing. Only parties with legal standing may appeal the final decision.
