

**NOTICE OF ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE RCRA RENEWAL PERMIT

The Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality Office of Land Resources (ADEQ) received an administratively complete Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) renewal permit application, dated January 19, 2018, from Rineco Chemical Industries. Any future RCRA permitting decision that ADEQ makes will be under the authority of the Arkansas Code Annotated (A.C.A.) Arkansas Hazardous Waste Management Act (A.C.A. §8-7-201 *et seq.*), as amended, and the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act of 1976, as amended (42 U.S.C. §6901, *et seq.*).

This notice of an administratively complete application satisfies the requirements of A.C.A. §8-4-203(b). The permit renewal application specifically involves the continued use of current RCRA permitted Hazardous Waste Management units designed to store and treat hazardous waste.

Persons may review the permit renewal application and the administrative record at the ADEQ Records Management Section located at 5301 Northshore Drive, North Little Rock, Arkansas. In addition, persons may also review the permit renewal application and the administrative record at the Haskell City, Hall, 2520 AR Highway 229, Benton, AR 72015.

Persons wishing to comment or request a public hearing regarding ADEQ's determination that the application is administratively complete must submit a written request within ten (10) business days of the date of publication of this notice. The request must be hand-delivered or post marked to the Department by close of business no later than March 14, 2018 at 4:30 PM CST. If ADEQ determines a public hearing is warranted, a public hearing will be scheduled and ADEQ will notify the applicant and all the persons who have submitted comments for the date, time, and place of the scheduled public hearing by certified mail.
