

NOTICE OF ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE CLASS 2 PERMIT MODIFICATION APPLICATION

On August 24, 2018, the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) Office of Land Resources (ADEQ) received a Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Class 2 permit modification request from Clean Harbors El Dorado, LLC. The facility is located in El Dorado in Union County, Arkansas.

ADEQ has determined the RCRA Class 2 permit modification request revised September 20, 2017 to be administratively complete. Any future RCRA permitting decision that ADEQ makes will be under the authority of the Arkansas Hazardous Waste Management Act (A.C.A. §8-7-201 *et seq.*), as amended, and the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act of 1976 (RCRA), as amended (42 U.S.C. §6901, *et seq.*).

This notice of an administrative completeness determination of the RCRA Class 2 permit modification satisfies the notification requirements of A.C.A. §8-4-203(d)(1) incorporated by reference by Arkansas Hazardous Waste Management Act (A.C.A §8-7-213). The RCRA Class 2 permit modification request involves changes to the groundwater monitoring requirements and Section E of the Part B application.

Persons may review the RCRA permit and the administrative record at the ADEQ Records Management Section located at 5301 Northshore Drive, North Little Rock, Arkansas. In addition, persons may also review the proposed permit modification request and the administrative record at the Barton Public Library, located at 200 East 5th Street, El Dorado, Arkansas.

Persons wishing to comment or request a public hearing regarding ADEQ's determination that the permit modification request is administratively complete must submit a written request within ten (10) business days of the date of publication of this notice. The request must be hand-delivered or post marked to the Department by close of business no later than October 19, 2018 at 4:30 PM Central Standard Time. If ADEQ determines a public hearing is warranted, a public hearing will be scheduled and ADEQ will notify the applicant and all the persons who have submitted comments for the date, time, and place of the scheduled public hearing by certified mail.
