

NOTICE OF INTERIM AUTHORITY

University of Arkansas, Fayetteville Campus
Permit No. 2011-AR-18 (Pending)

Notice is hereby given under Ark. Code Ann. § 8-4-230(e)(1) that the Director of the Division of Environmental Quality (DEQ), 5301 Northshore Drive, North Little Rock, AR 72118-5317, has granted University of Arkansas, Fayetteville Campus's request for an interim authority for construction and installation of the equipment associated with the Windgate Art & Design District for a period of ninety days pending permit review. Activities associated with the interim authority include installation of the equipment associated with the Windgate Art & Design District. These processes include various spray-painting activities, pottery kilns, and two natural gas fired water heaters. These activities will take place at the following site address:

This interim authority is limited to a period of no longer than ninety (90) days from the date granted or until a final permit decision is made on the pending application, whichever comes first. This decision is subject to and contingent upon the right of the public to object to the Director's decision. Any member of the public may object to the Director's decision or request a public hearing within ten (10) business days of the date of this notice. Objections or requests for a public hearing will be accepted if submitted no later than 4:30 pm Central Standard Time on the last day of the comment period. Written objections or a request for a public hearing should be sent to: Division of Environmental Quality, ATTN: Office of Air Quality, 5301 Northshore Drive, North Little Rock, AR 72118-5317.

After consideration of any timely written objections, the Director may revoke or modify the conditions of this interim authority within thirty (30) calendar days of the date of this decision for compelling reasons or good cause shown. The Director's revocation or modification of her prior decision becomes a final decision and will be sent to the applicant and those persons who submitted timely objections. If the Director's initial decision is not revoked or modified within thirty (30) calendar days of the date of the decision, the decision is deemed final for purposes of appeal.

As Chief Administrator of Environment, I execute the statutory duties of the Director of DEQ.
