A PDS records review prior to the investigation revealed that Firestone Building Products, LLC. was granted permission from ADEQ through a letter dated Dec 19, 2006 to the City of Prescott to accept the wastewater. A tour of the inside and outside of the facility revealed nothing that could be construed as hazardous wastewater. Firestone samples monthly for Zinc and Copper at the manhole before the effluent reaches the City collection system.
