This NPDES Industrial User Inspection was performed after the May 22, 2007, Compliance Evaluation Inspection at the POTW revealed that a Consent Administrative Order between Hanesbrands and Clarksville Light and Water. Mr. Eddie Shirley of Hanesbrands, Mr. Gregg Rainey and others from Clarksville L&W, Mr. David Long from EPA Region VI and the writer were present. A facility site review was performed at the pretreatment plant. The inspection revealed that oils contained in some of the various raw materials supplied to Hanesbrands have been passing through to the Clarksville Wastewater Plant adversely affecting the treatment processes.
