Section D: Summary of Findings/Comments (Attach additional sheets if necessary) This EPA-lead inspection was conducted by Juan Ibarra, USEPA, and John Fazio, ADEQ, on December 10, 2007. Issues discussed with James Boston, Public Works Director, included plans for the new WWTP. Mr. Boston indicated that the new SBR plant is to be constructed and completed in 2008. Permit compliance issues included: 1. Unpermitted discharge from waste/sludge pond. The discharge must be sampled for permit parameters, excluding TRC; 2. Data on lab bench sheets incomplete; 3. 7-day averages not calculated as required by the permit; 4. ph values not bracketed during calibration; 5. Percent error between primary and secondary flow devices >10% for 2 consecutive months, then % error calculation not conducted the following 2 months; 6. Lab thermometer not calibrated against an NBS traceable thermometer in over 1 year; 7. No controls limits established for duplicates; 8. Minor sludge and paper in receiving stream at outfall.
