Section D: Summary of Findings/Comments (Attach additional sheets if necessary) This recon inspection was performed in response to a tornado that tracked though the city of Clinton on February 5, 2008. A prior attempt to assess the plant by ADEQ Inspector Tony Morris was unsuccessful as access to the plant could not be made due to debris from the tornado. During the visit, it was found that the facility was currently off-line due to power outages across the city. Generators had been brought in to restore power to the plant but were not large enough. It was stated to me that a 300K generator from Little Rock was in route that day. Adequate storage capacity was still available in the pond for storing incoming wastewater. Crews from Little Rock Wastewater and Marshall Wastewater were assisting with sewer and water line breaks. The tornado did track across the facility but only inflicted minor damage to some of the buildings. No visible damage to the treatment works was found. It was stated that power was expected to be restored to the facility later that day. Susan Poe of Central Arkansas Rural Water Association was also on-site offering assistance to the facility. Water and Sewer Superintendent Rod Pruitt stated that some line breaks were to be expected due to tree removal but he didn't anticipate any major problems.
