Dear Mr. Bowman:

On May 2, 2008, I performed a sanitary sewer overflow inspection of the collection system at the intersection of N. Washington and E. Cornell in response to a complaint. This inspection was performed in accordance with the provisions of the federal Clean Water Act, the Arkansas Water and Air Pollution Control Act and the regulations promulgated thereunder. This inspection revealed the following:

There was evidence to confirm that raw sewage had overflowed from the sewer manhole located at the intersection of N. Washington and E. Cornell. This manhole is labeled Basin 6 Manhole #139. Clean-up efforts had been performed in the area where the discharge occurred by the evidence of lime that had been distributed across the ground. Tom Myers, Wastewater Superintendent in Siloam Springs, confirmed that the overflow had occurred and stated that it had been reported as required to the Department. The City's NPDES Permit also requires that all overflows be reported on the monthly sanitary sewer overflow report. This report had been submitted with April's Discharge Monitoring report.
