A reconnaissance level inspection was performed on September 10, 2008, in response to a complaint. The complaint alleged that the lift station at Trinnen Street overflowed routinely for several months, most recently the day before this inspection. The inspection did not reveal any evidence of a recent lift station overflow. Mr. Kirby Murray, Public Works Director, stated that the most recent overflow to his knowledge was on May 1, 2008. This overflow was reported to the Department. No violations were noted during this inspection.
