Dear Mr. Merriman:

On February 10, 2010, I performed a routine inspection of the city's wastewater collection system, specifically Gulpha Creek Pump Station, in accordance with the provisions of the federal Clean Water ACT, the Arkansas Water and Air Pollution Control Act, and the regulations promulgated there under. This inspection revealed that the manhole just prior to the Gulpha Creek Pump Station has had a significant overflow. Evident debris displays evidence of this overflow entering the waters of the state located just a short distance away. Since you have complied with the notification of noncompliance requirements of your permit, no further response is necessary pertaining to the overflow itself. However, I would like for you to address the debris that had been left behind as a result of this overflow.

The above item requires your immediate attention. Please submit a written response to these findings to Cindy Garner, Water Division Enforcement Branch Manager. This response should be mailed to the address below. This response should contain documentation describing the course of action taken to correct each item noted. This corrective action should be completed as soon as possible, and the written response with all necessary documentations (i.e. pictures) is due by March 2, 2010.

In talking with Craig Stevens (City of Hot Springs), he stated that due to the hurricane/tropical storm Gustav, the pump station lost power. The backup power source (generator) failed to start. Once power was restored, I and I became a problem causing further overflows. He has estimated that approximately 60,000 gallons overflowed at the station. He stated that he would report all of the overflows as required and disinfect and deodorize any areas needed.

Dear Ms. Garner:

In response to the letter dated February 19, 2010 from Jim McSwain concerning the overflow issue at Gulpha Pump Station. I want to offer the following status. We were on site (2/11/10) to complete the cleanup efforts related to the debris noted by Mr. McSwain. I have provided email communication along with photos of the site as we left it that day (2/11/10). I will of course attach them to this response for your records as well. The cleanup effort was delayed a day due to the inability to adequately access the site, however, we did dispatch crews and equipment on the next day to perform the clean up and to assess the situation. I personally visited the site and have since met with our Engineering Group to develop a plan to mitigate this type event to the extent possible.

Please understand that we do not intentionally ignore this type incident, we take this very seriously and are working towards eliminating all overflows as directed by the CAO. The unusual amount of rainfall is just something our system capacity cannot adequately handle. Please do not hesitate to call if you require additional information on this matter.
