Dear Mr. Garrett:

On June 24, 2010, I performed a complaint investigation/reconnaissance inspection of the waste water treatment facility in accordance with the provisions of the Federal Clean Water Act, the Arkansas Water and Air Pollution Control Act, and the regulations promulgated thereunder. Follow-up investigations were conducted on June 30, 2010, and July 12, 2010. This inspection revealed the following violations:

- 1. Placement of waste in such a manner that has the potential to cause the pollution of the waters of the State. This is in violation of the Arkansas Water and Air Pollution Control Act 8-4-217, (a)(1).
 - a. Biosolids had been land applied approximately 40-50 feet to Smyrna Creek and Holman Creek.
- Biosolids were land applied approximately 40-50 feet to Smyrna Creek and Holman Creek. This is in violation of Part III, Condition 15 of your permit. When land applying biosolids, a 100 foot setback to all lakes, ponds, springs, streams, wetlands, and sinkholes must be met.
- 3. Biosolids were not evenly distributed in an area located in Whorton Field 1. This is in violation of Part III, Condition 11 of your permit. Biosolids must be spread evenly over the application area.

In addition, necessary steps must be taken to prevent biosolids from leaking out of the truck onto the roads during transport.

The above item requires your immediate attention. Please submit a written response to this finding to Cindy Garner, Water Division Enforcement Branch Manager. This response should be mailed to the address below. This response should contain documentation describing the course of action planned to correct the item noted. This corrective action should be completed as soon as possible, and the written response is due by August 26, 2010.

Mrs. Cindy Garner,

The following is my response to a complaint investigation inspection of the wastewater facility performed by Alison West.

We had a driver that applied Biosolids to close to Smyrna Creek and Holman Creek both in the same field. He allowed Biosolids to pile up in small piles behind the truck, not performing an even spread of the Biosolids and was not cleaning his tires off before leaving the field and entering the roadway.

- 1. As soon as this was brought to our attention by Alison we went immediately and spread the piles out.
- 2. The driver was transferred from the wastewater facility and another operator was transferred in from another department. He has been trained on sludge handling and the 100 foot setbacks he must meet from all lakes, ponds, springs, wetlands, sinkholes and streams.
- 3. He has also been instructed to clean tires and equipment before entering the roadway.

These corrective actions were done immediately after Alison's visit on June 30, 2010 which was the day I found out about the violation.

I apologize for our department having made this mistake but I am sure that it has been corrected. Our new sludge handler/driveris very responsible. I am assured that he has been properly trained and will take pride in doing a good job.
