Section D: Summary of Findings/Comments (Attach additional sheets if necessary)										
A compliance assistance inspection was performed at the request of the facility. Facility had questions regarding an industry (Barrett Plastic Corporation) in the city which was proposing an expansion of their facility which would generate 50,000 gpd of non-contact cooling water at between 60 and 65 degrees F. Cooling water disposal options being considered are (1) discharge via city storm water system to Dry Jordan Creek to Crooked Creek, (2) discharge to the POTW and (3) Discharge into an underground injection well. After a preliminary review of applicable rules and regulations, City was informed that Options 1 & 3 were viable, but would require possibly lengthy individual permitting (NPDES for #1 and UIC for #3) and that Option 2 would only require written notification to ADEQ by the POTW. Option 1 may possibly violate the City Sewer Ordinance. City was advised to check with the ADH to make sure that their requirement to connect to a public sewer system did not apply. Written response from ADEQ with final determinations is being prepared by Water Division Permits staff. On another issue, City asked and was informed that an on-site operator was not required 24/7.
