Dear Mr. Henderson:

On February 8, 2012, I performed a reconnaissance inspection of the Mountain View waste water collection system in accordance with the provisions of the Federal Clean Water Act, the Arkansas Water and Air Pollution Control Act, and the regulations promulgated thereunder. This inspection revealed the following violation:

An overflow was occurring due to inflow and infiltration exceeding the capacity of the lift station. The overflow was reported to the ADEQ Water Division Enforcement Branch in a timely manner. No further action regarding this overflow is required at this time.

The city will begin a major collection system upgrade this spring which will include rehabilitation of lift stations, a new transmission line from the Hwy 66 West lift station to the POTW and identification and repair of sources of inflow and infiltration. Section D: Summary of Findings/Comments (Attach additional sheets if necessary)

- The Hwy 66 West Lift Station has been discharging to Hughes Creek for an extended period of time. A waste water flow of approximately 20 gpm was estimated to be discharging to the receiving stream. The lift station has been discharging for many days based upon the amount of debris, sludge and grease noted around the lift station and the channel to the creek.
- A meeting was held with J.R. Henderson to discuss the discharge. Mr. Henderson stated that the city will soon begin a major sewer system upgrade which will include rehabilitating the Hwy 66 West lift station and the addition of a new 10 inch diameter transmission line to the POTW.

***Although a letter was drafted with the inspection report on February 10, 2012 notifying the permittee of the violations, neither the letter nor the inspection report was entered into ADEQ records. The inspection has been entered into the ADEQ records on October 26, 2012. NO LETTER SENT – Jason Bolenbaugh (Inspector Supervisor)**
