The Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality – Office of Land Resources (ADEQ) conducted a routine inspection of your facility pursuant to the Arkansas Solid Waste Management Act (Arkansas Code, Annotated, § 8-6-201 <u>et seq.</u>), of 1971, as amended, the Arkansas Pollution Control & Ecology Commission Regulation 22 (Solid Waste Management), and the above-referenced permit. The inspection identified conditions at your facility which the ADEQ alleges constitute violations of APC&EC Regulation No. 22. A copy of the inspection report is attached.

Please refer to the attached inspection report to note the specific allegations. A written response for the noted allegations, describing the corrective action taken, or to be taken, must be submitted within thirty (30) calendar days from the date of this letter to the attention of Tobin Baker. Failure to submit the written response shall be construed as an admission of any allegations. Any items noted that are neglected or persistent may warrant formal enforcement action.





This letter is in Response to noted Allegation at The Crittenden County Class 1 Landfill, Located 1299 Khun Rd. West Memphis, AR 72301 Permit Number 0245-S1-R1.

As noted on your Routine Class 1 Landfill Inspection on 4/12/2018

- 1. Regulation 411 (h) (i) Contouring Prevents Surface Water Flowing Into or Through Waste was observed.
- 2. Regulation 411(o) Leachate leak or evidence of leachate seepage.
- 3. Regulation 429 Leachate collection system.
- 4. Regulation 309 (c) Overfill/Off lined area.

Corrective Action: Noted Allegations 411(h) (i) was corrected by fill and grading area, also by stopping heavy equipment from entering area.



Corrective Action: Regulation 411 (o) was corrected by digging out mattress and replacing void with cover.



Corrective Action: Noted Allegation 429, Pump had bad wire had Able Electric fix immediately.

Able Electric installed complete new wire.

Corrective Action : Noted Allegation 309 (c) was a misunderstanding with Sullivan Survey. See attachment email from Fields & Associates, on the confusion.

Afternoon John,

I completed a review of the points that were staked by Sullivan Survey on the Northeast top deck of the landfill. These points are from the design drawings for the proposed major permit modification. Fields & Associates, LLC resurveyed these points and compared them to the ADEQ permitted interim cover grades (Sheet 4A of 20). In the Table below is a summary of results of the survey and the estimated amount of fill remaining in this area.
