The City of Clinton has boilerplate pretreatment language in the individual NPDES permit (see Part II, Condition 7 and Part III, Sec D, 8 of the permit). It is the city's responsibility to identify any indirect discharger (i.e., Industrial User) to the city's collection system and wastewater treatment plant and require them to comply with the requirements outlined in the individual NPDES permit.

SUMMARY OF FINDINGS

As required to demonstrate compliance with Part II, Condition 7, A, 3 and 4 and under direction of Part II, 7, B of the permit, Natural State Processing must conduct an influent sample of the discharge. This influent sample must be after the catch basin and during a processing event to be representative of the volume and nature of the discharge to the city's collection system. The sampling will include analyses for Total Suspended Solids (TSS), Oil and Grease (O&G), Biochemical Oxygen Demand (BOD5), Chemical Oxygen Demand (COD), and Ammonia Nitrogen (NH3-N). Sampling must comply with requirements outlined in 40 CFR 136. Natural State Processing must supply the results of the analyses to the City of Clinton to report to ADEQ. Based on information obtained from sample results, the IU may be required to implement additional preliminary and primary treatments prior to the city's collection system.

GENERAL COMMENTS

On March 26, 2019, an inspection was conducted with the above-mentioned inspection participants. The inspection consisted of a site assessment.

Natural State Processing is leasing part of the building at 345 Quality Drive in Clinton, AR from Global Performance Group, Inc. The Operations Manager for Natural State Processing, Andy Shaw, was not onsite at the time of the inspection, but he was spoken to via telephone while onsite. Mr. Shaw stated that Natural State Processing processed 91,000 chickens last year and they are a little over that pace for this year. Chickens are processed two days a week onsite. There is a bleed tunnel and a catch basin where process water and rendering are collected. Premium Protein Products, LLC picks up 35-gal drums of the chicken renderings. Some of the organs are packaged and sold. A copy of the City of Clinton's pretreatment ordinance was left onsite for Andy Shaw.

There was a large amount on chicken feathers and grease/fat found in the city's collection system discharged by Natural State Processing. Best Management Practices (BMPs) need to be implemented to prevent feathers, offal, and other sources of pollutants that may contributor to interference within the city's collection system and wastewater treatment plant. The city is pumping out the Industrial Park lift station once a month because of issues generated by Natural State Processing.






Figure 1. Google Earth image depicting location of photos from areas of the collection system. Natural State Processing Manhole picture Industrial Park Lift Station
