SUMMARY OF FINDINGS
The following violation was noted during the inspection:


There has been an unpermitted discharge of wastewater treatment residuals (i.e., sludge) from the treatment plant. This is a violation of Part 1, A of the permit.

## **GENERAL COMMENTS**

On April 14, 2023, I performed a reconnaissance inspection in response to a complaint alleging solids associated with wastewater treatment accumulating downstream of the City of Decatur WWTP. I observed treatment residuals accumulating near a bridge over Columbia Hollow Creek downstream of the treatment plant (Photos #1 - #4; Attachment 1). These were not observed upstream of the treatment plant (Photos #5 - #6; Attachment 1). I was unable to access the plant directly during the inspection due to the facility being closed and personnel absent, but a voicemail was left with the number posted at the facility with my contact information and reason for the site visit.

Following my departure from the permitted area, I was contacted by James Boston with the City of Decatur. I explained my observations to Mr. Boston and he stated that the city was aware of a release that occurred due to a hydraulic overload during a heavy storm resulting in partially treated wastewater overflowing the plant and entering the receiving stream. Mr. Boston stated that this was reported electronically to the DEQ - Office of Water Quality - Enforcement Branch (Attachment 2). Previous observations of overflows at the City of Decatur WWTP have been referred to the Enforcement Branch and the City of Decatur is considering upgrades to the treatment plant in order to adequately address the flows received at the facility. Details from this inspection will be forwarded to the Enforcement Branch for further review.
