The Arkansas Division of Environmental Quality Office of Land Resources (DEQ) conducted a routine inspection of your facility pursuant to the Arkansas Solid Waste Management Act (Arkansas Code, Annotated, § 8-6-201 *et seq.*), of 1971, as amended, the Arkansas Pollution Control & Ecology Commission Regulation 22 (Solid Waste Management), and the above-referenced permit. The inspection identified conditions at your facility which the DEQ alleges are violations. A copy of the inspection report is attached.

You should immediately initiate actions to correct the alleged violations cited. A written response of the corrective actions taken, or to be taken, must be submitted within thirty (30) calendar days from the date on this letter to the attention of Kim Davenport. The response may include, but is not limited to, photographs, copies of disposal receipts, records, or analytical results, as applicable. Enclosed are the results of the Second Quarter 2023 explosive gas monitoring event conducted on June 7, 2023 at the BFI Saline County Landfill (Landfill). Explosive gas monitoring was conducted at the eleven (11) barholes and fifteen (15) gas monitoring probes. Please note the gas measurements for methane at gas monitoring probe GP-1, GP-2, GP-3, GP-13 and GP-15 as well as barhole 7, barhole 8, and barhole 9 reported methane above the 100% Lower Explosive Limit (LEL). Measurements in the remaining barholes and monitoring probes were below regulatory limits for the facility. As part of the nature and extent plan, the explosive gas plan will be revised once the perimeter gas monitoring system has been approved.
