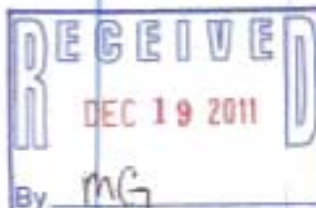

**Project Description**

1. The District currently utilizes the services of Marck Recycling to sort and process recyclables collected through the Craighead County "Kurby" blue bag program. The ten municipalities within the Craighead County RSWM District offer recycling to residents, seven of the ten provide curbside pickup for recyclables which are then taken to Marck Recycling. This public/private cooperative helps the District with the goals in the Solid Waste Management Plan of providing recycling for the residents of Craighead County.
2. Administrative Grant Funds are requested to provide funding for administration costs involved with coordination of and reporting on the solid waste and recycling activities, as well as the licensing of solid waste haulers.
3. The desired short-term outcome is for a higher rate of participation in recycling for District residents, with an increase of tonnage. Long-term benefit will be a sustained recycling habit, with creative and new methods of reducing the waste stream and extending the life of the landfill.
4. Administration of the recycling program is a year-round activity so the project will begin prior to the next grant round. Grant funds for administration are needed throughout the year so the funds will be expended prior to the three-year expenditure requirement.
5. The project will encompass the entire District (Craighead County) with a population of 96,443. The promotions are targeted toward residents in single-family dwellings in incorporated areas; however, the Recycling Education Coordinator also focuses on educators, citizen's groups, and industrial facilities in the District. Seven of the municipalities offer curbside recycling, while the other three allow recycling drop-off at the City Hall.
6. The CCRSWMD contracts with Judith Long, Recycling Education Coordinator, to work with schools, civic organizations, and other entities to set up recycling programs. The District provides recycling bulletins and blue bags with recycling information printed on them. This information is given to every new homeowner as well as given out by each of the City Halls. Bulletins are also handed out at events, and mailed out to those who request it. A website, [www.ccswda.com](http://www.ccswda.com) also provides recycling information.

10. No. 1 and No. 2 plastics, tin cans, aluminum cans and clear glass will be recycled through the "Kurby" blue bag program. Marck Recycling in Brookland transports recyclables to their Rogers, Arkansas location for marketing.

11. Marck Recycling provides the District with gross tonnage amounts and such tonnage broken down by category for reporting purposes. Angela Sparks, Deputy Director of the CCRSWMD, maintains these records for the District. 12. The Administration services will not generate revenue as it is for service to the project; however, without Administration services, the program would suffer in reporting and proper handling of grant funds.


