3.0 PROJECT DESCRIPTION

3.1

The District has recently purchased the RLH Landfill in Mountain Home. With this recent acquisition the District should be able to broaden its horizon to other recycling goals. We have recently embarked on the daunting task of electronics recycling. With the recent banning of electronic waste from the landfill by the previous owners, the District has implemented a program whereby electronic waste can be recycled at area recycling centers. The District will continue to diligently foster the growth of recycling in the upcoming year by focusing on technical assistance and the administration of recycling grants in the following areas:

Goal 1	Continue to assist Searcy County and the City of Marshall in the development of a joint recycling center
Goal 2	Continue developing a district wide program to collect electronic waste
Goal 3	Work with the Boone County and the City of Harrison to develop a recycling center

The District is continuing to work with elected officials in Searcy County and the City of Marshall to establish a recycling program. Elected officials have recognized the need for a recycling facility and are trying to acquire the needed land to start this project.

Early this year the District began meeting with recycling coordinators to determine how best to establish an electronic waste program. One major concern was that the recycling centers would be inundated with electronic waste and not have the financial means necessary to pay the disposal fees. It was decided that the most economical means to recycle this type of material would be to offer the service but not advertise at this juncture until we have a chance to see what kind of response we would receive from the public.

We were disheartened to learn the citizens of Harrison voted down their curbside recycling program this year. However, the citizens and businesses still have access to the county run recycling center in Harrison. The District will continue to work with elected official both on a county and city level to continue developing and implementing a program that would be agreeable to all parties.





Vehicle registration

Utilities including telephone

Office equipment

All grants are subject to the requirements of A.C.A §8-6-601 et. seq. and Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission Regulation 11, Chapter Five: Solid Waste Management and Recycling Grants Program. Highlights include:

Grant Recipients agree to:

- Conform to all state laws on the purchase, use or sale of equipment and facilities secured with grant funds.
- Have design plans for construction of permanent facilities with an estimated cost of \$50,000 or greater approved by a professional engineer unless otherwise approved by ADEQ.
- Seek competitive bids or requests for proposals (RFP) for purchase of equipment or services with an estimated cost of \$10,000 or greater. This should be done through an advertisement in an area newspaper of general circulation.
- > Start grant project before application deadline for the next grant round. Delays must be approved in writing by both the RSWMD and ADEQ.
- Develop the recycling program presented in the application and expend all grant funds within three years. Extensions must be approved in writing by both the RSWMD and ADEQ.
- > Actively seek to market or reuse materials collected in three years.
- Use any interest earned on grant funds exclusively for this or other recycling programs.
- Maintain an orderly accounting system to document that grant expenditures are made in accordance with project budget. This includes keeping copies of all bids, paid invoices, canceled checks, and other appropriate paperwork.
- > Report to the RSWMD for five or more years as directed by ADEQ & the board.
