1. WE CURRENTLY HAVE RECYCLING CONTAINERS IN HOWARD, PIKE AND SEVIER COUNTIES AND THE CONTENTS WHICH ARE ALUMINUM, PLASTIC, PAPER AND CARDBOARD WHICH GO TO THE HOWARD COUNTY CHILDREN CENTER IN NASHVILLE FOR RECYCLING. WE ALSO SELL SCRAP METAL THAT WE GET FROM CLASS I AND IV.
- 2 & 3. WE ARE GOING TO EXPAND AND IMPROVE RECYCLING IN OUR DIRSTRICK BY PURCHASING TEN 20 YARD RECYCLING CONTAINERS. WE ARE GOING TO PLACE CONTAINERS IN ,HEMPSTEAD, LITTLE RIVER, MONTGOMERY, HOWARD AND SEVIER COUNTIES. WE WILL USE OUR TRUCK TO HAUL HEMPSTEAD, LITTLE RIVER, HOWARD AND SEVIER COUNTIES TO THE CHILDREN'S CENTER. MONTGOMERY COUNTY WILL HAUL THEIR THREE BOXES TO THEIR TRANSFER STATION AND PROCESS AND SELL THE MATERIAL.
4. I WILL BID THE CONTAINERS AND AS SOON AS WE RECEIVE THE CONATINERS WE WILL PUT THEM INTO OPERATION.
5. IF WE HAVE ANY MONEY LEFT OVER WE WILL TRANSFER IT TO ANOTHER GRANT.
6. WHEN WE STARTED THIS RECYCLING PROGRAM WE RAN ADS IN THE LOCAL PAPERS. PIKE COUNTY JUDGE DON BAKER HAD AN ARTICLE IN HIS LOCAL PAPER THAT WORKED VERY WELL AND WE PLAN TO TRY THAT IN THE OTHER COUNTIES.

The authorized representative of the organization applying for the grant and the Regional Solid Waste Management Board Chairman both must sign and date the application. The authorized representative must have the authority to obligate the applicant's resources.

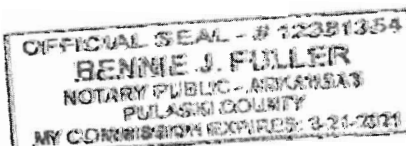
