Good Afternoon Mayor Black:

DEQ has received a report that you plan on resigning your office at the end of the day, August 12, 2020 and that you have dismissed Bethel Heights wastewater employees.

Bethel Heights is still legally obligated to comply with the Consent Administrative Order LIS 19-070, Benton County Circuit Court Judgment and State No-Discharge Permit 4725-WR-5 requirements until the vote is certified on August 21, 2020.

Please provide DEQ an update on how Bethel Heights will continue to manage its wastewater and respond to wastewater issues that may arise until the vote is certified and Springdale Water Utilities can take over the wastewater operations.
