These permit schedule requirements are due this month:

Certification of Completion (1-P-75305)	04/13/2018	Submit a written certification, signed by the responsible official, that the equipment has been installed and is operational.
Complete Required Work or On-Site Construction (1-P-CS016)	04/01/2018	The permittee must have the stream flow monitoring equipment installed to measure the stream flows downstream of Outfalls 006 and 007. This equipment must be operating within six (6) months of the effective date of the permit.

Your email on January 24, 2018, stated that, "We now have the equipment set up and will be submitting written certification shortly."  
However, I don't see any notification or certification of that in our files, but that doesn't mean the document wasn't sent.

If you can get a letter or email to me confirming that the stream flow monitoring equipment has been installed and is functioning, I'll get that coded and off the list. The quicker the better.

The written certification, signed by the responsible official, isn't due until April the 13<sup>th</sup>.

Please take a look at the permit (part 2 of 1B) it states, "the permittee must have the stream flow monitoring equipment installed to measure the stream flows downstream of Outfalls 006 and

007. This equipment must be operating within six (6) months of the effective date of the permit. The permittee must submit a written certification, signed by the responsible official, that the equipment has been installed and is operational 195 days of the effective date of the permit.” We now have the equipment set up and will be submitting written certification shortly.
