### DAILY MONITORING RESULTS – ANNUAL REPORT

The results of daily monitoring activities for the Georgia-Pacific Crossett Paper Operations for the 2014 reporting period are:

Summary: As detailed in the Georgia-Pacific Crossett Paper Operations BMP Plan, Total Organic Carbon (TOC) is the monitored parameter used to detect spills or leaks of spent pulping liquor, soap, or turpentine. All daily composite samples are collected at the P1 and P2 sewers.

For the 2014 report year the Georgia-Pacific Crossett Paper Operations exceeded the Upper Action Levels five (5) times and exceeded the Lower Action Levels ten (10) times. However, exceedance of these action levels does not constitute a violation of our permit according to 40 CFR 430.03 (i)(3).

Exceedances of the Lower Action Level require an investigation to determine the cause. Exceedances of the Upper Action Level require corrective actions to reduce the TOC loading.

All investigation reports are available for agency review.

8	31-Aug-14	X		The pine filtrate tank overflowed soap and foam which exceeded the containment capacity - this allowed some soap to enter the sewer. The pine pulpmill was shut down and a vacuum truck was called to remove soap remaining in containment area.
9	9-Sep-14	X		Runnability issues on the pulpmill washer led to excess carry over.
10	13-Nov-14	X		The Dissolving tank overflowed briefly when being put back in service.
11	4-Dec-14		X	The pine washer was taken off line for an outage, and the dissolving tanks overflowed. As soon as the overflow ceased, the levels returned below the LAL. No other corrective actions were taken.
12	5-Dec-14		X	The Dissolving tanks ran over while bringing the boiler back up. As soon as the overflow ceased, the levels returned below the LAL. No other corrective actions were taken.

The remaining soap was recovered as soon as the issue was discovered and returned to the process. In addition some black liquor carried over when the hardwood washer was shut down.

This also caused the discharge valve on the weak black liquor filter to fail spilling approximately 200 gallons of weak black liquor to the sewer. The sump pump was air locked and the operator had to get it running. The card was changed out as soon as possible and the discharge valve was closed.
