Please accept this email as a 24-hour report to inform you that Georgia-Pacific Consumer Operations (NPDES Permit #AR0001210) has exceeded our daily maximum concentration limit for copper. The analytical report was received earlier today from the contract lab, which showed the copper concentration to be 43 ug/L. The daily maximum limit is 18.75 ug/L. The loading for that same sample was calculated to be 14.0 lbs/day, which is below the daily maximum limit of 14.12 lbs/day. We intend to have this sample reanalyzed.
