Good afternoon Ms Graham,

I wanted to send notification that a brief spill-upset occurred Friday morning (February 09) at the Paul R Noland WWTF (AFIN 72-00781, AR0020010).

- While Operators were working to clear debris from a clarifier scum-pump, backflushing caused an estimated 150-gallons of untreated wastewater to spill over the wet-well's containment wall and onto facility grounds.
- Operators quickly stopped the spill by shutting the scum pump off; as both a corrective and preventive measure Operators have scheduled all Secondary Clarifier (scum) wet-wells to be drawn down using the city's vac-truck.
- Wastewater solids have been collected, and lime applied to the impacted area.
- Again, the release of untreated wastewater was onto facility grounds only, and no receiving waters impacted.

No adverse environmental impacts have been observed and none are expected.
