Good afternoon Mr Pemberton,

I wanted to send notification that Saturday afternoon, July 04th, the Noland facility experienced an unpermitted release of fully treated W3 effluent from an unexpected line break, estimated to be 200,000 gallons, some of which drained into a nearby unnamed tributary of Roberts Creek, a tributary of the White River.

The initial response was to stop the W3 release by shutting off the Effluent Pump Station's W3 pump. Facility and city's Utility staff are currently working on a permanent line repair. Repairs are anticipated to be completed by end of the day.

No adverse environmental impacts have been observed.
