Sanitary Sewer Overflow (SSO) Corrective Action Plan (CAP) Request

Dear Mayor Jordon,

ADEQ has conducted a review of certified Discharge Monitoring Reports (DMRs) submitted from the closing of your previous SSO CAP on July 19, 2016, through November 16, 2017. The review revealed that there have been thirty-four (34) SSOs and bypasses. A detailed list of the violations is included with this letter. As a result of this review, ADEQ requests that City of Fayetteville submit the following documentation to the ADEQ Office of Water Quality, Enforcement Branch:

- A Corrective Action Plan (CAP). The CAP shall be certified by a Professional Engineer (PE) registered in the state of Arkansas and at a minimum, the CAP shall include the following information:
 - The causes of the SSO and bypass violations.
 - Evaluation of the current permitted collection and treatment system for compliance within the requirements of your permit.
 - The actions to be taken to correct, and prevent, the recurrence of the violations.
 - A milestone schedule for compliance with the requirements of your permit, with a final date of compliance not to exceed December 31, 2018.
- Monthly progress reports. These reports shall describe the progress made and the remaining items to be completed. Submission of Monthly Reports shall be due on the 15th of the following month. Please begin submitting the monthly reports to the ADEQ Water Division Enforcement Branch within sixty (60) calendar days of receipt of this letter. The reports may also be emailed to pemberton@adeq.state.ar.us.

- A final report, stamped by a P.E. licensed in the state of Arkansas, certifying compliance with the permit upon completion of actions taken to correct, and prevent, the recurrence of the SSO and bypass violations.

Within thirty (30) calendar days of receipt of this letter, please submit a CAP to the ADEQ Office of Water Quality, Enforcement Branch. The document may be emailed to me at pemberton@adeq.state.ar.us.
