

CERTIFICATION STATEMENT FOR PRETREATMENT PROGRAM
TECHNICALLY BASED LOCAL LIMITS (TBLLs)

“I, Tim Nyander, the Utilities Director and authorized representative of the City of Fayetteville Paul R. Noland Wastewater Treatment Plant hereby certify under penalty of law that the Technically Based Local Limits provided with this statement were prepared under my direction and supervision in accordance with a system designed to assure that qualified personnel properly gather and evaluate the information submitted. Based on my review of the Local Limits hereby provided and my inquiry of the person or persons who manage the system, or those persons directly responsible for gathering the information, the information submitted is, to the best of my knowledge and belief, true, accurate and complete. I further certify that the Local Limits submitted are adequate to prevent; (1) pass through of pollutants which cause exceedances of applicable water quality standards after adjustment for low-flow stream dilution, (2) inhibition or interference, (3) worker health and safety problems and/or (4) sludge contamination which causes exceedances of applicable standards. Neither this certification nor the proper development and implementation of the Local Limits shall provide relief from compliance with all applicable standards or act as a waiver of liability, including liability resulting from such pass through, inhibition or interference, worker health and safety problems and/or sludge contamination.”
