The Division of Environmental Quality – Office of Water Quality (DEQ) received and reviewed the Inspection response, dated September 29, 2021, addressing the violations listed in DEQ's October 20, 2020. The response was deemed adequate.

Your submissions adequately address the compliance issues with DEQ. However, DEQ does not preclude any future enforcement action deemed necessary. If future violations occur that require enforcement action, DEQ may consider the failure to timely respond to the inspection conducted on October 20, 2020, as required by Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission Rule 7, Civil Penalties. This rule requires DEQ to consider the history of your facility and how expeditiously violations were addressed in determining any civil penalty that may be necessary for any future violations.
