Danielle, the City has secured financing through USDA in the form of a combination loan and grant. Final design of the project is in progress and should be complete and ready for submittal to the Health Department in late September to early October.

The City had more issues with the RAS pump station. We worked with the City and received permission from ANRC to use a portion of their reserve funds to go ahead with replacement of the RAS Station. This was portion of the rehab project that was planned. The RAS pumps have been ordered and will be installed in November. We will inspect and asbuilt the work and report to you its progress as its completed.
