## SIGNIFICANT CHANGES FROM THE PREVIOUSLY ISSUED PERMIT

The permittee is responsible for carefully reading the permit in detail and becoming familiar with all of the changes therein:

- 1. The facility's mailing address and driving directions were removed from the cover page.
- 2. The coordinates for Outfall 001 were updated based on an inspection report dated August 18, 2020.
- 3. Tiered limits and requirements were added to Part I.A; Part I.A.1 was added for Tier I limits for the facility's existing, pre-construction treatment system and design flow of 0.175 MGD; Part I.A.2 was added for Tier II limits applicable for the post-construction treatment system and design flow of 0.35 MGD.
- 4. All existing mass limits and the concentration limits for TSS and NH3-N in Part I.A were updated to one decimal place per updated Office of Water Quality (OWQ) rounding procedures.
