The Discharge Monitoring Reports (DMRs) submitted for the 10/31/2009 and 3/31/2010 Monitoring Periods, Discharge Number <u>001A</u> has been received by the Department. Please submit the corrected DMRs, clearly marked as "Corrected Copy", with the changes highlighted. Submit two legible copies of the corrected DMRs with an <u>original</u> <u>signature and date</u> (RE-SIGN and RE-DATE) by the Cognizant Official. These corrected copies should be received by the Department by **June 7, 2011.**
