Enclosed is an Administrative Order (AO) issued to the City of Nashville for violations of the Clean Water Act (CWA) (33 U.S.C. § 1251 *et seq.*). Violations were identified during a review of the permit file and discharge monitoring reports submitted for the City of Nashville. The violations alleged are for failure to meet permit effluent limitations for Whole Effluent Toxicity and for a failure to conduct a WET retest for the test species *Pimephales promelas*. The EPA requests that you immediately confirm receipt of this e-mail and the attached order by a response e-mail to [juarez.paul@epa.gov](mailto:juarez.paul@epa.gov).

This AO does not assess a monetary penalty; however, it does require compliance with applicable federal regulations. The first compliance deadline is thirty days from the effective date of this Order. The Environmental Protection Agency is committed to ensuring compliance with the requirements of the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) program and my staff will assist you in any way possible. Please reference AO Docket Number CWA-06-2023-1818 and NPDES Permit Number AR0021776 on your response.
