
Dear Ms. Porter:

It was noted, ADEQ allows for a portion of the fine to be used toward environmentally approved projects. The City has been involved with Howard County on the demolition of the existing old County hospital which contains a large amount of asbestos. The County has secured a third of the funding to complete the project and is applying for an EPA grant for another third of the amount.

The City of Nashville has cut a check in the amount of \$875.00 to be paid to Howard County pending approval by ADEQ to be used in funding the removal of the asbestos and lead paint throughout the original 1949 hospital located in the north central part of the City. The County's long term goals are to complete the removal and necessary demolition of the facility. The property and remaining buildings will be recommissioned for County use. The County is working on obtaining the remaining funding through the Southwest Arkansas Planning District.

This facility is currently unusable in its present state. The County and City have continued to work toward obtaining the necessary funds to allow for the safe removal of the asbestos.

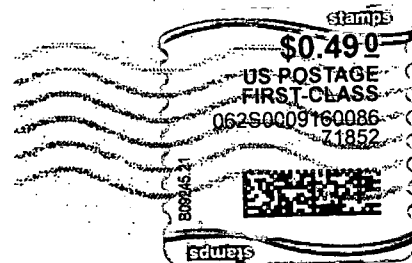
