Dear Mr. Dunaway:

A review of the NPDES file for the City of Nashville reveals the following compliance issues that require immediate action:

The facility has reported twenty two (22) violations of Part I, Section A., Effluent Limitations and Monitoring Requirements of NPDES Permit No. AR0021776. A detailed list of these violations has been included with this letter. Although the Department acknowledges that the City of Nashville is currently working toward compliance with the final effluent limitations for Nitrogen Ammonia, compliance with all of the interim effluent limits established in Part I, Section A. was required on the effective date of the Permit, which was February 1, 2009.

The following Discharge Monitoring Reports have been deemed deficient or have not been received by the Department.

- DMR End Date 01/31/09, Discharge TX1A.-DMR did not include sample measurements for Whole Effluent Toxicity (Daily Ave Min, %) and (7 Day Min, %).
- DMR End Date 03/31/09, Discharge TX1Q.-DMR did not include a sample measurement for Noel Sub-Lth Statre 7 Day Chronic Ceriodaphnia,
- DMR End Date 09/30/09, Discharge 001Q-DMR was not received at the Department.
- DMR End Date 09/30/09, Discharge TX1Q- DMR did not include sample measurements for Whole Effluent Toxicity (Daily Ave Min, %) and (7 Day Min, %).
- DMR End Date 12/31/09, Discharge TX1Q-DMR was not received at the Department.
- DMR End Date 06/30/10, Discharge TX1Q.-DMR did not include sample measurements for Whole Effluent Toxicity (7 Day Min, %).

The Department has not received the Status/Progress Report toward meeting the Final Limitations for Nitrogen Ammonia established in Part I, Section A. of the Permit. This report was due on February 1, 2010.

Please submit the delinquent/corrected Discharge Monitoring Reports with any applicable Non-Compliance Reports and the Status/Progress Report to the Department by January 5, 2010. Each DMR should include an original signature and date by the Principal Executive Officer or Authorized Agent.

Any violation of your NPDES Permit is subject to enforcement action by this Department, pursuant to the Arkansas Water and Air Pollution Control Act. The regulations and your NPDES Permit require that you take all reasonable measures necessary to eliminate or prevent the occurrence of violations. <u>The NPDES file for the City of Nashville will be reviewed again in</u> February 2011 in order to determine if formal enforcement action is necessary.
