As per my phone conversation with Ms. Trotta, this electronic transmittal is notification of Little Rock Wastewater's intent to bypass the secondary treatment process and blend with secondary effluent prior to disinfection at the Adams Field Wastewater Treatment Facility. The combined flow will be sampled for compliance with permit limits in accordance with the limits and sampling frequencies set forth in Part 1A of the NPDES Permit.
