Dear Mayor Chase:

A review of the Permit file for the above mentioned facility for the period of January 1, 2019 through April 30, 2019 reveals the following compliance issues:

The facility has reported **4 violations** of Part I, Section A of Permit No. AR0021831:

Additionally, the City of Monticello submitted the TX1-Q Discharge Monitoring Report for the 1st quarter of 2019 thirty-three (33) days late. This is a violation of Part III, Section C, Condition 5 of your Permit.

Any violation of your NPDES Permit is subject to enforcement action by this Department, pursuant to the Arkansas Water and Air Pollution Control Act. The regulations and your NPDES Permit require that you take all reasonable measures necessary to eliminate or prevent the occurrence of violations.
