Please be aware that a complete renewal application must be received by the Department no later than 10/2/2017 in order to continue discharging wastewater after the expiration date of the existing permit. Any NPDES permit that expires without the receipt of a renewal application will no longer be valid. This will be a violation of your current permit, and operating without a valid permit is a violation of federal and state regulations.

Please be advised that the above referenced NPDES Discharge Permit will expire on 3/31/2018. The Department previously notified you of the upcoming permit expiration in a letter dated 4/4/2017 (See attached letter). To date, our records indicate that the required renewal application has not been submitted.

Even though there is still considerable time to submit the renewal application (approximately 90 days), you **MUST** be aware that a complete renewal application must be received by the Department no later than **10/2/2017** in order to continue discharging wastewater after the expiration date of the existing permit. Any NPDES permit that expires without the receipt of a renewal application will no longer be valid. This will be a violation of your current permit along with federal and state regulations.
