Dear Mayor Trahan:

DEQ has reevaluated the Whole Effluent Toxicity (WET) tests performed by American Interplex Corporation from September 2016 to January 2019. Upon reevaluation, the chronic WET test for *Ceriodaphnia dubia* conducted for Outfall 001 during November 2018, as required by NPDES Permit No. AR0022004 did not deviate from the maximum test duration specified in EPA-821-R-02-013. This test has been deemed valid.

DEQ will make the necessary corrections to the TX1-Q Discharge Monitoring Report for December 31, 2018, to reflect the original submission.
