Dear Mayor Trahan:

The Department has conducted a review of the Whole Effluent Toxicity (WET) tests performed by American Interplex Corporation from September 2016 to January 2019. The review revealed that the chronic WET test for *Ceriodaphnia dubia* conducted for Outfall 001 during November 2018, as required by NPDES Permit No. AR0022004 (Permit) deviated from the maximum test duration specified in EPA-821-R-02-013. This test has been deemed invalid.

Please correct the TX1-Q Discharge Monitoring Report (DMR) for December 31, 2018 to reflect "NODI M - Laboratory Error" and attach this letter as your non-compliance report. This correction should be made by June 1, 2019.

Reporting Laboratory Error on your DMR is a violation of Part I, Section A of your Permit. The Department has elected not to take formal enforcement action for this violation of your Permit.
