- 2. Tim Verner gave everyone an update on the progress that has been made concerning the Corrective Action Plan.
  - a. RJN submitted their final report detailing a model with a 2-year/24-hour design
    - i. Dr. Bob Blanz asked for documentation justifying a 2 year return when the Water Quality Standard for the receiving stream is a 10 year return
  - b. He made note that the WWTF has two main issues at this point
    - i. Influent channel is undersized
    - ii. Hydraulics of the clarifier make it difficult for the system to handle all of the flow
- 3. Proposed CAO was discussed
  - a. A Revised Corrective Action Plan will need to be submitted
  - b. A revised penalty reduction request with dollar amount will need to be submitted
  - c. RJN will need to re-analyze their report based on the comment by Dr. Blanz above, and so WMU may need to revise their Hydraulic Improvement Report
  - d. Bryan Leamons asked about the status of the Permit Compliance Schedule concerning the TBLLs. The first report has been submitted. The second report is still due.
