
RE: UPDATE ON ACTIVITIES FOR CORRECTIVE ACTION PLAN WEST MEMPHIS UTILITIES

NPDES PERMIT NUMBER AR0022039, AFIN 18-00879

Dear Mr. Hickey:

On behalf of West Memphis Utilities (WMU), please accept the following as an update of activities undertaken since our last update in June 2022. As outlined in WMU's Amended CAP, WMU outlined a plan of action through June 2023. Listed below is a capsule summary of those activities either completed or underway since the CAP was implemented.

- WMU continues to meet regularly with their CAP Working Group. Members of this group
 include Ward Wimbish, General Manager WMU; Denise Bosnick, Director of Environmental
 Quality, WMU; and Paul Holloway, WWTP Manager, WMU. Also included in these monthly
 meetings as necessary are Tim Verner, P.E., and Chase Carpenter, Fisher & Arnold, and Mac
 Compton, P.E., RJN Group. This group directs and tracks on-going efforts by WMU staff and
 all outside consultants and contractors relative to efforts towards the elimination of
 systemwide SSOs.
- 2. Argo Construction has completed the installation of the common force main and awaits delivery of Pump Station 3 that has been delayed due to the availability of computer chips for its control panel. The current delivery date for this unit is August 28, 2023. Once delivered, Argo will then be able to install this station, along with Pump Station 4 and make the new system operable. Expected substantial completion is now October 2023.



- 3. Since our last semiannual report in December 2022, WWTF staff has reported two bypass events totaling approximately 35 million gallons. Additionally, since January 1, 20023, there has been 18 reported sanitary sewer overflows through June 1, 2023.
- 4. Bids were received by WMU for the WWTP Expansion on June 21, 2023. Two bids were submitted: one from Max Foote Construction Company, LLC, at \$43,123,000.00, and the other from Chris-Hill Construction Company, LLC, at \$62,040,000.00. Currently, the bids have been reviewed and the Engineer has made a recommendation to WMU to award this project to Max Foote in the amount referenced above. It is noted, however, that additional funding will be required to fully fund this Project. It is also noted that due to the long delivery time required for much of the equipment, and the impact the level of the Mississippi River has on excavations adjacent to the levee where the plant is located, an extended construction period of 28 months will be required to see substantial completion of this Project. An award is expected in August 2023.
- 5. Between the period of December 1, 2022, and June 26, 2023, WMU has invested an additional \$1,484,245.01 in the planning, engineering, replacement, and/or repair of their sewer collection and treatment systems. Of this total, \$1,433,347.22 has been for actual rehabilitation, replacement, or upgrades of existing infrastructure. The remainder has been for advance planning studies and/or design of sewer infrastructure repairs, rehabilitation, or replacement.
- 6. WMU's contractor has completed thirty-six of the forty-four-point repairs to existing sewer mains and laterals with an expected completion date of late August 2023. The completion of these repairs will then allow WMU to move forward with the commencement of CIPP of existing gravity sewer mains identified in previous SSES Reports prepared by RJN. This CIPP work is planned to commence late 2023.
- 7. WMU is planning to commence 60 to 75 days of post-rehabilitation flow monitoring after the completion of the work to Pump Stations 3 and 4, and the scheduled CIPP work referenced above. With the delay in the completion of the point repairs and the PS3/PS4 with Common Force Mian project, the post-rehabilitation flow monitoring is expected to be delayed until Summer 2024.

8. With the contract for the construction of the WWTP Expansion project anticipated to be awarded in August 2023, and the required construction time estimated to be 28 months, it is clear that WMU will be unable to meet the December 31, 2023 deadline outlined in the CAO. Since this CAO was entered, WMU has steadily made progress towards the completion of those items outlined in the approved CAP. However, challenges outside WMU's direct control have made the completion of these efforts by this date impossible. As such WMU will be in contact with ADEQ to begin the process of requesting an extension to this deadline.

Hopefully, this summary of activities is useful to you and your staff and demonstrates the commitment of WMU to eliminate SSOs in their collection system and WWTP bypasses. If you require any additional information, please do not hesitate to contact me at this office.
