**Compliance Tips for Small Wastewater Treatment Lagoon Systems**

Dear Mayor Rieder:

In June 2022, the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) issued a Compliance Advisory titled "Compliance Tips for Small Wastewater Treatment Lagoons with Clean Water Act Discharge Permits" for owners and operators of small wastewater treatment plants (WWTPs). It includes information to help WWTPs meet the effluent limits in their National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permits.

The Compliance Advisory discusses common causes of effluent violations and recommended solutions. It also includes compliance and financial aid resources to assist small publicly and privately owned lagoon wastewater treatment plant permittees and operators in complying with their NPDES permit.
