I then forwarded the information collected to the city code enforcement team.

The leaking sewer line is a private force main extending from a private lift station at 2900 SW I St to the sewer tap connection at manhole # 446-1610. The sewer overflow was on the north end of a drainage ditch at SW I and SW Anchor Way. The sewer matter was flowing into the drainage ditch. Property owners were told to fix their sewer service. I have sent this information over to our code enforcement team see this situation through.
