SIGNIFICANT CHANGES FROM THE PREVIOUSLY ISSUED PERMIT

The permittee is responsible for carefully reading the permit in detail and becoming familiar with all of the changes therein:

- 1. The mailing address was removed from the cover page.
- 2. The description of the receiving stream was updated to include Pemiscot Bayou.
- 3. The CBOD5 concentration limit and mass limits for CBOD5, TSS, NH3-N, and Copper were updated due to a change in rounding procedures.
- 4. The FCB limits for April were revised. See Section 12.A of this Fact Sheet for additional information.
- 5. The monitoring frequency for Total Phosphorus (TP) and Nitrate + Nitrite Nitrogen (NO3 + NO2 N) was reduced to once per quarter in Part I.A. See Section 12.A of this Fact Sheet for additional information.
- 6. The monitoring requirement for Arsenic and minimum quantification level condition in Part II.9 of the previous permit was removed. See Section 12.E of this Fact Sheet for additional information.
- 7. The pretreatment report was removed from Part I.A since it was incorporated in Part II.7.
- 8. The Copper and Mercury limits were updated. See Section 12.A and 12.E of this Fact Sheet for additional information.
- 9. New WET lethal and sub-lethal limits for P. promelas and C. dubia were included in the permit. See Section 13 of this Fact Sheet for further information.
- 10. The requirements to measure sludge in the sludge lagoon and develop to remove the sludge were included in the Part I.B of the permit.
- 11. The requirement to monitor the influent CBOD5 and TSS was removed from Part II.2 of the permit.
- 12. The Sanitary Sewer Overflow (SSO) condition was revised in Part II.5 of the permit.

- 13. The sludge disposal condition in Part II.8 of the previous permit was removed. Sludge disposal is addressed in Part III.B.6 of the permit.
- 14. A monitoring frequency reduction condition was included in Part II.10 of the permit.
- 15. Part III.C.5 of the permit now requires that DMRs be submitted electronically via NetDMR.
- 16. The twenty-four hour reporting condition was revised in Part III.D.6 of the permit.
- 17. The discharge of toxic substances condition was revised in Part III.D.8 of the permit.
