Dear Mr. Asher,

The submitted TX1-Q WET tests for the 3rd quarter 2018 and the 1st quarter 2019 had discrepancies as noted below:

The lab report was not attached to the 2018 3rd quarter WET Test for September TX1-Q. Please submit the full report by **May 21, 2019.**

According to NPDES Permit No. AR0034002 Part II.14.4.a. "The permittee shall prepare a full report of the results of all tests conducted pursuant to this part in accordance with the Report Preparation Section of EPA-821-R-02-013, for every valid or invalid toxicity test initiated, whether carried to completion or not. The permittee shall retain each full report pursuant to the provisions of PART III.C.7 of this permit. The permittee shall submit full reports."

The Department requests that full WET test reports are consistently submitted along with the DMR to the Department when any such test is conducted. WET test reports should be submitted electronically through NetDMR; PDF is the preferred format.

The K1902-011B chain of custody form noted a sampling date of November 2018 but a test date of February 2019. Please confirm the validity of this information and if necessary, submit the correct reporting. If this information is valid and correct, then the dates exceed the hold time according to Part II, Condition 14.3.d.iv of your Permit, which states "The permittee must collect the composite samples so that the maximum holding time for any effluent sample shall not exceed 72 hours. The permittee must have initiated the toxicity test within 36 hours after the collection of the last portion of the first composite sample."

Please submit the required information for the 2019 1st quarter WET Test for March TX1-Q by **May 21, 2019.**
