Dear Mr. Ledbetter:

The Department received your letters in regard to a release from the sludge storage lagoon that included wastewater from the equalization basin. Based on the information provided; the permit does not allow for wastewater from the sludge storage lagoon to be blended with the effluent discharge. This is an unauthorized bypass of the primary and secondary treatment processes of the treatment plant.

The following violations were found in response to the release of wastewater from the sludge storage lagoon and equalization basin.

## 1. Part III (B)(1) Proper Operation and Maintenance (referenced title)

The Department has determined that if proper operation and maintenance had been implemented; the permittee could have prevented the unauthorized bypass. Improper operation and maintenance transpired due to the permittee's delinquency to maintain levels of wastewater in the sludge storage lagoon and equalization basin.

## 2. Part III (B)(4)(C)(1)(b) Unauthorized Bypass (referenced title)

The Department has not approved any plans to allow wastewater from the sludge storage lagoon to bypass primary and secondary treatment processes. The wastewater from the sludge storage lagoon should have been returned to the head works of the plant to be treated.

Please submit plans to the Department pertaining to the decommissioning of the outfall in the sludge storage lagoon to prevent future unauthorized bypasses. The plan should be submitted to the Water Division Permits Branch within thirty (30) days of this letter.
