WE FEEL THIS PROBLEM WAS DUE TO:

DURING THE SECOND WEEK OF AUGUST HIGH FLOW INTO THE WASTE TREATMENT FACILITY OVERLOADED THE 1 MGD PROCESS CREATING LESS DETENTION TIME . WE BELIEVE THAT THERE WAS NOT AN ADIQUIT AMOUNT OF NITRIFYING BACTERIA IN THIS BIO-MASS TO CHANGE THE AMMONIA AND ORGANIC NITROGEN INTO OXIDIZED NITROGEN. AS A RESULT WE WERE OVER OUR 7-DAY WEEKLY LIMIT DURING THE SECOND WEEK OF AUGUST. AS A RESULT OF THIS WEEKS RESULTS IT ALSO PUT US OVER OUR MONTHY CONCENTRATION LIMIT, IF NOT FOR THOSE RESULTS OUR CONCENSTRATION FOR THE MONTH WOULD HAVE BEEN WELL BELOW OUR LIMIT.

WE PLAN ON CORRECTING THE PROBLEM IN THIS MANNER: FLOW FROM THE 1 MGD PROCESS WAS REDUCED AND TREATED IN THE FACILITIES 2 MGD PROCESS

THE RESULTS ON THE ANALYSIS TAKEN THE NEXT WEEK ON THE 14th OF AUGUST WERE 0.151 mg/l.
