The manhole rehabilitation project described in the previous monthly progress report will be submitted to both the Arkansas Department of Health (ADH) and the funding agency for review and approval no later than Friday, February 28.

Seven (7) sanitary sewer overflows (SSOs) were observed during the month of February 2025. The SSOs are summarized in **Table 1**:
